



When working with both animals & Children Health & Safety is of paramount importance, not only for the Children but all our clients young and old and the animals too.

Our Ranger is extremely experienced and qualified in the animal handling field and will take every step to ensure your experience is safe and low risk.

Before the Animal Handling begins our Ranger will explain the basic rules and provide anti-bacterial gel at the end of the show to ensure all hands are clean.

#### Snake

Risk	Action
Biting	All snakes used vary in size but all are non -
	venomous. There is a risk of biting but the Ranger
	is in control of the head at all times to minimize
	risk. If biting occurs ranger will secure animal and
	seek medical assistance.

### **Lizard**

Risk	Action
Biting, scratching & tail whip	Ranger to handle lizard at all times, customers
	are instructed how and where to stroke safely.

# **Tarantula**

Risk	Action
Biting & irritating hairs	Ranger to handle tarantula but it will be in a
	secure box when in close proximity to customers
	to eliminate risk.

#### <u>Rat</u>

Risk	Action
Biting and minor scratching	All the rats used are hand reared and very
	friendly. The Ranger will supervise at all times to
	reduce aforementioned risks.

#### Scorpion

Risk	Action
Stinging	The Scorpion will remain in a secure box at all
	times





# **Rabbit & Guinea Pig**

Risk	Action
Biting	Although the rabbits are hand reared and
	friendly there is still a small chance of biting. To
	this end the ranger will be in control of the
	rabbit giving the audience opportunity to stroke
	& hold under supervision.

# Frog/Toad

<u>Risk</u>	<u>Action</u>
Escaping	Frogs / toads will be kept in a secure container.
	The animals will be handled under the
	supervision of an experienced presenter. If the
	animal escapes it will be recovered by the
	presenter.

# Cockroach

Risk	Action
Escaping/scratching	The presenter will keep cockroaches in a secure
	container. Cockroaches will be handled under
	the supervision of an experienced presenter and
	if it does escape the presenter will recover the
	animal

#### **Millipede**

Risk	Action
Biting	Millipedes can secrete a chemical along their
Scratching	back if they feel threatened. This can cause
Poisoning	illness if ingested. Millipedes must only be
Escaping	handled under the supervision of an
	experienced presenter. If the millipede does
	secrete this chemical then the participant
	affected must go and wash their hands
	immediately. The presenter will keep the
	millipede in a secure container and it will be
	handled under the supervision of the
	presenter. If the millipede escapes the
	presenter will recover the animal.





# **Giant African Snail**

Risk	Action
Escaping	The presenter will keep the snail in a secure
	container. The snail will be handled under the
	supervision of an experienced presenter and if it
	does escape the presenter will recover the
\	animal.

# Hedgehog

Risk		Action
pricking		The presenter will advise how to safely stroke
		the animal.

#### **Katydid**

Risk	Action
Escape	Katydids will be kept in a secure container. The
	animals will be handled under the supervision of
	an experienced presenter. If the animal escapes
	it will be recovered by the presenter.

# **Action**

All animals are kept in a secure box until ready to be handled, they are then returned to the secure box as soon as the animal handling for that animal has been completed. A qualified Ranger will be in control of the animals at all times and should this occur the Ranger will recover the animal.

# Health and Safety

As a business that works with both animals and members of the public "Jaws N Claws" take all health and safety issues very seriously.

# Animals used

All animals used in the show are chosen primarily because of their calm and friendly nature. All animals are handled on a daily basis to ensure animals are content in the situations they are placed in.

Animals are also health checked on a daily basis to ensure they are all in top condition for handling and any animals showing signs of illness or disease will be taken to the vet for advice and treatment and will not be used in any shows until they are fit to do so.

"Jaws N Claws" ensure a high level of hygiene when working with the animals. All enclosures in which the animals are kept in are cleaned out on a regular basis.

# Set up

The workshops work best when participants are sat in a circle or around desks. This enables the presenter to move around the room safely.

Children must be supervised by the appropriate number of adults.

# Handling the animals

Before the animals are touched, the presenter will explain to participants the importance of washing their hands after touching the animals. At the end of the workshop the presenter will remind everyone to wash their hands and will also provide anti-bacterial hand gel for participants to use.

During the workshop all of the animals will be kept in secure boxes and participants will not be allowed to touch these boxes. The animals will be handled by the presenter or under strict supervision of the presenter regardless of age and experience with the animals.

#### **Phobias**

The presenter will be sympathetic with all phobias, participants who feel they need to, can leave the room while a particular animal is being looked at.

Nobody will be made to do anything they don't want to.

#### Allergies

Before the session anyone with any allergies should notify the presenter so they can avoid going to close with that particular animal and the participant can just look.

Anybody with severe allergies are advised against taking part in the show.
